In the glass, our estate-grown Sauvignon Blanc clone offers up intriguing floral tones alongside aromas of lemongrass and Meyer lemon peel. On the palate, these give way to classic varietal flavors of ripe pineapple, fresh honeydew melon and candied lime with a bright, cleansing citrus finish.

- Marine influence from the San Pablo Bay makes Oak Knoll a “sweet spot,” with temperatures averaging 10°F cooler than Upper Napa Valley
- Oak Knoll typically has the longest growing season in Napa Valley
